



## Jean-Pierre Garson

Jean-Pierre Garson is Head of the International Migration Division in the Directorate for Employment, Labour and Social Affairs of the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), based in Paris. Before joining the OECD in late 1988, Mr. Garson was professor of economics at the University of Paris XI.

Mr. Garson is responsible for the publication of the OECD Annual Report International Migration Outlook (former Trends in International Migration) and other OECD publications related to international migration. Until 2008, he has also been in charge of issues concerning employment and social policies in non-member economies.
